## Structure of HF – Opening Paragraph

- -Twain creates "voice" of Huck (stage puppet)
- -Limited point of view
- -Regular language used for narration controversial! ("not appropriate for children" original complaint)
- -Made American speech something to be proud of
- -1<sup>st</sup> time American speech used for serious narration
- -"Liberated" American literature cut it loose from proper grammar and elegant lofty speech.
- -We don't hear Twain's voice
- Ernest Hemingway called the novel "the beginning of American literature"
